TCAC Resident Initiatives Program

provides training and services to promote leadership and self-sufficiency for residents living in public housing. Some of the services provided to public housing communities are resident training conferences, and on-site resident academies. TCAC's Resident Initiatives Program provides training and guidance on establishing a resident council, resolving conflict, program development and fundraising. TCAC resident training events offer great networking opportunities and host nationally recognized speakers and trainers.

TCAC Community Cares AmeriCorps Program

serves the very frail, elderly and challenged residents of Tennessee so they can remain living independently with an improved quality of life. AmeriCorps members not only provide assistance with daily tasks, but more importantly they help the residents maintain their dignity and confidence. The services are provided with no cost to the residents.

TCAC Depot Redistribution Program

helps TCAC's partners, other non-profits, and churches throughout Tennessee provide products and incentives that further the individual agency's mission. TCAC Depot redistributes new products that assist partnering agencies in stretching their service dollars while providing materials and supplies to Tennesseans most in need.

TCAC Making Veterans Priority Program

serves veterans and their families who are homeless or in danger of becoming homeless due to the lack of income, physical and/or mental health issues, disabilities, trauma, substance abuse, and weak social networks. TCAC's MVP Program places AmeriCorps members at agencies and non-profits that serve veterans being affected by these risk factors, but also seeks to prevent veteran homelessness by making veterans and their families a priority BEFORE they find themselves without a primary, permanent residence to call home.

TCAC Community VISTA Project

is one of the largest privately funded VISTA programs in the United States. VISTAs serve in low income communities and non-profit organizations making meaningful changes that affect the health, safety, economic stability, and attitudes of residents that live there. VISTAs develop and strengthen programs and communities while recruiting and training volunteers to build capacity and make a difference in Tennessee.
